

Tomatoes and Peppers

Although tomatoes require the most attrition by far their program approach is very similar from the product application standpoint.

- **<u>Transplanting</u>**: Both crops are transplanted to the field do the following products will be of real benefits.
 - **Transplant Starter:** primarily used in transplant water at 1-2 quarts per 100 gallons of transplant water.
 - **Organic Matter:** used in transplant water at 3-4 quarts per 100 gallons of transplant water.
- <u>Early Foliar Spray:</u> Crop Power-47 for early application is the ideal choice. Apply from one week after field set up to bind stage when **Poblano Pro** applications begin.
- **Fruiting Sprays:** Poblano Pro will be you choice on both tomatoes and peppers with the first spray coming from bind to early bloom.
- <u>Determinate Tomatoes:</u> These are mostly grown for mechanical harvesting (cammers). Characterized by a big single flush of blooms. Here you want to apply **Poblano Pro** at landing stage and repeat in a week or 10 days. You would be advised to apply **ENZROT** also just as the small tomatoes begin to form.
- <u>Indeterminate Tomatoes:</u> Begin Poblano Pro applications on same schedule. Timing as determined above. Repeat every 10 days throughout season.
- <u>Peppers (all types):</u> Treat as with indeterminate tomatoes.
